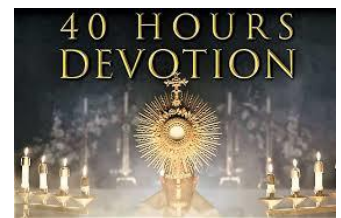
**Weekend of Nov. 30/Dec. 1 – Catholic Book Sale**
