CROSSES AND STATUES ARE COVERED IN PURPLE We now enter into "Passiontide": the fifth week of Lent and Holy Week. The Church of God begins to mourn Her Spouse. We recall, ponder and pray about the saving Passion of Jesus. We give thanks for the "infinite power of [His] majesty... the wondrous power of the Cross now revealed and the authority of Christ crucified". And we cover in purple cloth the statues and crosses in our Cathedral Church. It is a kind of penance and mortification for the eyes and the heart. Our holy temple becomes more austere. We centre our attention on Christ Who suffered for us. Now is not the time for publicly honouring the Saints, who take a back seat, although we continue to ask for their intercession and above all the prayers of the Virgin. The Cross is hidden until it is uncovered, revealed on Good Friday. The Saints remain hidden until the Easter Vigil.
